

Teacher Shortage

Teachers are leaving the profession at all times highs; declining numbers of new teachers

High Cost to Recruit and Retain Teachers

Preparing high quality & resilient educators takes time and money

Relationships Take Time to Cultivate

Transformative efforts require strong relationships between K12 and Higher Education. Those relations require significant time and efforts from partners.

Fewer Teachers; Lower Educational Attainment

The lack of high quality teachers reduces the amount of learning that takes place in schools and will have a generational impact on educational attainments.

High Societal Costs

Lower educational attainments decrease health, increase incarceration, decrease the tax base, and negatively effect an economy's innovation ecosystem


The Problem






Our Approach

1. Recruitment starts in jr. high and early high school with affinity groups and mentoring by MU faculty




